The You Will Be Found Scholarship

The *You Will Be Found Scholarship* is designed to further promote diversity and inclusion at Junior Theatre. Each year, up to four students, between the ages of 8-17, will receive a one-year-long scholarship that covers one Junior Theatre class or camp per session (total of four) and all production fees.

The scholarships will be awarded on the opening night of Junior Theatre's spring production of *Diary of a Wimpy Kid*, on April 26, 2024.

The ideal scholarship candidate will be new, or have had limited access to Junior Theatre and possess the following qualities:

- Inspired by some aspect of theatre
- Looking for a place to belong
- Has something unique (not necessarily theatre-related) to bring to the Junior Theatre community

Equity Diversity and Inclusion at San Diego Junior Theatre

San Diego Junior Theatre aims to create and sustain a community of diversity and inclusion, where everyone feels safe, welcomed and represented. An inclusive environment makes our community stronger. Diversity is not limited to one's religion, ethnicity, culture, language, ability, gender identity, or sexual orientation. *It's whatever element of your identity that distinguishes you from others.*

You can also demonstrate diversity through your interests, opinions, hobbies, talents, values, or life experiences. Perhaps you are an ally, or stood up for someone at a time when they were being excluded for being different.

Applicants must turn in the following to be considered for this scholarship:

1. Completed Application
2. Letter of Interest (see prompts below)
3. Household Information
4. One reference (a teacher, mentor, neighbor, community leader, but not a family member)

The student's letter of interest should include a 2-3 paragraph response to one of the prompts below. The prompts are only suggestions and you may choose one from either list, no matter your grade.

Suggestions for Students Grades 1-6

- Who are you? What makes you different from others? What makes you special?
- Describe a community to which you belong and your place within it
- If you could choose a super power, what would it be and why?

Suggestions for Students Grades 7-12

- Describe the world you come from and how you might add to the diversity of Junior Theatre
- Describe a situation from your life that demonstrates the importance of diversity
- Give an example of how you stepped up as a leader or served your community
- How might your personal experiences, perspectives, or talents contribute to the Junior Theatre community
- Describe a life event you experienced or that changed your viewpoint, opinion, or belief

Completed applications must be submitted to San Diego Junior Theatre's Administrative office by March 15, 2024. Candidates must be available for an interview. We will contact you to schedule an appointment.
